The Evergreen Children's Chorale (ECC) is a community of staff, volunteers and parents brought together with the goals of inspiring and engaging each of our members through quality performing arts programming. As ECC prepares to re-open following our closure associated with the COVID-19 pandemic, we ask that you join us in reaffirming your partnership with ECC so as to ensure the safety of our community.

We understand that children exhibiting any symptoms of illness will not be allowed at rehearsal or performances. We will take our child's temperature before leaving for ECC and will keep them home if they have a fever of 100.4 or above or are exhibiting other symptoms of illness.
We understand that ECC staff will be doing health screenings and taking the temperature of staff, students, and any others entering the rehearsal space and that no one with a fever of 100.4 or above or exhibiting symptoms of illness will be allowed to participate.
We understand that symptoms of illness in our household may require our family to self-quarantine and not come to rehearsal for an extended period. We understand that ECC's staff has the ultimate discretion regarding when it is safe for our family to return and that documentation from a physician may be required.
We understand that the rehearsal hours have been adjusted and we will do our best to minimize late drop-offs and pick-ups within the general time ranges provided. We understand that these time frames and the drop-off and pick-up process may change as deemed necessary.
While at ECC, we agree to wear masks, to clean our hands upon entering the building, to engage in social distancing from other adults and children, and to not come to ECC while experiencing any symptoms of illness.
To keep our community safe and to limit our community's exposure, we agree to adhere with the current state and local guidelines regarding social distancing when away from ECC.
We agree to notify ECC staff within 24 hours and before returning to ECC of any illness in our household, any exposure to someone with COVID-19, and any travel outside of the country or to high risk states or areas.
We understand that, during this initial re-opening period, some of ECC's practices may be altered to reduce the risk of community transmission. We agree to support these practices, as communicated by our staff and as they evolve in response to changing circumstances and health guidelines.
ECC will notify your family of confirmed or suspected cases of COVID-19 in our community. We understand that it may be necessary for ECC to cancel in-person rehearsals for 24 hours or longer in response to illness in our community.
We understand that ECC has updated, and may need to continue updating, its Member Handbooks, General Release, and other documents to reflect current circumstances. I will carefully read these documents as well as ECC's COVID-19 Guidebook and agree to adhere to these policies.

We understand that, despite ECC's best efforts at mitigating risk, ECC cannot guarantee safety or prevent
students or parents from contracting any illness. Should we have any concerns or suggestions regarding the
school's efforts to mitigate the risks associated with COVID-10, we will address them to ECC's staff.
